St. Thomas' Episcopal Church Vestry Meeting November 16, 2021

Present: John Davis, Carolyn Cockerham Wiggins, Sue Liverman (by telephone), Bill Blanchard (by telephone), Barbara Outland, Becky Johnson (Senior Warden), Colin Jones (Junior Warden), Cecelia Jones (Clerk), Jeff Douglas (Rector), Ernie Carter (Treasurer).

Absent: Linda Blackburn.

Meeting held in person in the Parish Hall. The Rector called the meeting to order at 6:02pm with a prayer.

Colin Jones moved, and Barbara Outland seconded, that the October minutes be approved. The minutes were approved unanimously.

Prior to the meeting, Becky Johnson forwarded the quote for the gutter installation from BM Roofing to Vestry via email. The total quote was \$6,825.75. Colin Jones moved, and Barbara Outland seconded, to move forward with the gutter installation project as outlined in the quote from BM Roofing. The decision to move forward with the gutter installation was approved unanimously.

Remodeling the sacristy has been delayed until the after the first of the year due to the contractor's schedule.

The Rector has procured Advent Calendars for children. The Rector contacted the parents of children in our church about distributing those Advent Calendars to the children of St. Thomas' prior to the start of Advent.

The Treasurer presented the Treasurer's Report, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. The Treasurer will effectuate a withdrawal in the amount of \$20,000.00 from the Raymond James Account as was unanimously approved in the October Vestry meeting. The Treasurer's Report was approved unanimously.

The 2021 Lobster Feast raised \$5,424.22 (net). Cecelia Jones moved, and Becky Johnson seconded, to distribute the proceeds from the 2021 Lobster Feast as follows: ½ to the Ahoskie Food Pantry; ¼ to Episcopal Relief and Development; and ¼ to the Rector's Discretionary Fund. The distribution of 2021 Lobster Feast net proceeds as outlined hereinabove were approved unanimously.

The Diocese has requested that parishes pledge 11% of a parish's 2020 Operating Income. Colin Jones moved, and Carolyn Wiggins seconded, that St. Thomas' 2022 Diocesan Pledge equal 11% of our 2020 Operating Income, which equals \$18,979.00. The motion was unanimously approved.

The Safe Church requirements were discussed, a copy of which was emailed to Vestry by the Rector prior to the meeting. Per the General Convention and the Diocese, all parishes must implement these policies. Colin Jones agreed to head the committee to implement these policies and trainings as outlined therein.

Hugh Davis presented his findings from the 2021 Mutual Ministry Review Survey. Prior to this meeting, Hugh forwarded Notes/Observations from the Mutual Ministry Review Survey, 2021, which summarized, in a narrative format, the findings from the 2021 Mutual Ministry Review. Hugh Davis will send a copy of the Notes/Observations from the Mutual Ministry Review Survey, 2021 to Julie for her to include in the next newsletter.

As our Rector has recently announced his upcoming retirement as of March 1, 2022, transitional logistics were discussed. The Rector noted that Bishop Skirving and/or Canon Roberts have indicated a willingness to meet with Vestry for consulting purposes as we navigate this process. In light of news of the Rector's retirement, it was commented that the topics of discussion in the small-group dinners Vestry is planning to host with the church's members in early 2022 will include conversation about the transition and will seek the input of our members as to the direction in which they would like to navigate the church. The Clerk will create a Google Document to circulate among Vestry for talking points during these dinners. Further announcements will be made to members at the Annual Meeting and Vestry will reach out directly to their dinner invitees to plan a convenient night for dinner. The goal is to have these dinners take place during January 2022.

As the Rector did all the coding for the church's website, he will provide information pertaining to website access to Vestry. It was noted that it is time for a website update.

There will be no Soup Kitchen in November.

The December Vestry meeting is on December 14.

Lessons and Carols is on December 19.

Christmas Eve service is 5PM on December 24.

The Rector will be away December 26 and January 2.

The Annual Meeting is on January 9. We will plan on it being a covered dish luncheon; however, this is subject to change depending on the pandemic.

Cecelia Jones moved, and Barbara Outland seconded, to adjourn the meeting.

The meeting adjourned at 7:09pm with the Lord's Prayer.
